ABSTRACT

The following article report the case of a 72-year-old female with no relevant pathological history, who is admitted due to chronic secretory diarrhea, oropharyngeal dysphagia, proximal muscle weakness, dermal involvement and multinodular goiter; with images and complementary studies compatible with the diagnosis of a benign VIPoma associated with paraneoplastic dermatomyositis and type IIIC polyglandular syndrome due to the concomitant present of Hashimoto's thyroiditis and autoimmune pancreatitis. The patient with corticosteroids pulse therapy, immunosuppressants received treatment (cyclophosphamide) and somatostatin analogues; evolving favorably, and being discharge following out patient management. This is the first case reported in our Country. This is the first case reported of this association in our country.
